



VISUAL IDENTITY GUIDE September 2017



INTRODUCTION

This booklet is a guide for the correct usage of the New Hope For Families logo and is the starting point for establishing its visual identity.

It is important that persons involved in the reproduction of the New Hope For Families identity and materials are fully aware of all the standards and limitations. It is essential to maintain the visual consistency of the New Hope For Families logo and materials by conscientious observation of the principles included in this Style Guide. There will be situations that will require you to make exceptions to these rules, but use good judgement based on the information that follows.

The final logo files are broken out into the following folders:

nh_Logo_Color

This folder contains the logo files, in AI*, EPS*, JPEG**, and PNG** formats.

nh_Logo_Black

This folder contains the logo files in black, white and grayscale, in AI, EPS, JPEG, and PNG formats.

nh_Logo_White&Green

This folder contains the logo files in black, white and medium green, in AI, EPS, JPEG, and PNG formats.

nh_Logo_White

This folder contains the logo files in black, white and grayscale, in AI, EPS and JPEG, and PNG formats.

nh_Design Elements

This folder contains extra design elements in four-color, in Al, EPS, JPEG, and PNG formats.

This folder contains a PDF of this document that you are reading

*Al and eps files are the logo versions to be used for printing.

*PNG and JPG files are to be used for digital purposes only.

THE NEW HOPE FOR FAMILIES LOGO


The New Hope For Families logo consists of a "Tree of Hope" mark with the words "NEW" in Gotham Book, "HOPE" in Gotham BOLD, "FOR" in Gotham Light, and "FAMILIES" in Gotham Book.



CLEAR SPACE

In applications where the logo is placed on a page with other elements, there must be enough negative space around it to ensure its full impact.

The minimum space that should be left clear around the logo is defined as \mathcal{X} , or the width of the tree. This minimum space should be maintained as the logo is proportionately resized.

LOGO COLORS

The logo can only be used in the color combinations found in the approved logo files only.

Four-Color

For occasions of 4-color printing, use nh_logo_color.eps



Dark Backgrounds

On dark backgrounds, with four-color priniting, use the nh_logo_whiteandgreen.eps



Monochromatic

For occasions of one-color printing, use nh_logo_grey.eps



Monochromatic on Dark Background

If you are limited to one-color printing and need to reverse the logo, use nh_logo_white.eps



SPECIAL APPLICATIONS

80% Tint

The nh_logo_20_white.eps file, with the transparency set at 20% can be found used on a green ground as a decorative element.







Tree Pattern

The nh_pattern._light.eps, nh_pattern._med.eps, and nh_pattern._dark.eps, can be used screened back as a graphic background, or at 100% on the inside covers of New Hope brochures.







THINGS TO AVOID

Proportions

The proportions of the logo should never be altered.



Altering the Angle

Do not rotate the logo.



Embellishments

Do not add embellishments like drop shadows, embossings, etc. to the logo.

Backgrounds

Be wary of placing the logo on a colored background that would obscure the legibility of the logo or the type.



Do not place the logo on a background that's so busy that it obscures the legibility of the logo or type.



Wrong Colors

The logoYou may not change the colors of the logo with one exception...


